Eunice Theresa Krohn Van Zandt passed away peacefully on the morning of Sunday, September 19th at the age of 95. Eunice, always filled with spirit and enthusiasm for life, enjoyed fishing, board games, football games, gardening, dancing, cooking her special dishes and spending time with family and friends. She was always ready to greet you with her sweet smile, a firm hug, and a long hold of your hand.

Although the past few years brought many challenges to Eunice, particularly separation from family, she always had a smile and chuckle for those who visited with her. Until the very end, she wanted only to spend time together with those she loved.
