Alex Trevor Bowman, born August 21, 1998, passed away on Sunday, January 5, 2014, at the age of 15. He was a resident of Albany and a 10th grade student at Albany High School, where he excelled in academics and athletics. Health, fitness, and nutrition were priorities in his life and one of his proudest accomplishments was lettering in track and cross country. 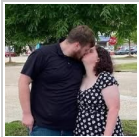
