Alvin "Punkin" Curtis Ryan, age 75, passed away on September 27, 2024. He was born and raised in Ponchatoula where he graduated from Ponchatoula High School and was named Mr. PHS in 1967. Following his graduation, he enlisted in the United States Marine Corps and fought overseas in Vietnam. In his two years he received a medal for Nation Defense Service, the Vietnamese Service medal; and the Combat Action ribbon. During his service he was also recognized for his athleticism in football. Alvin dedicated 31 years to his career at Dupont as a shift mechanic, and over 40 years as a commercial fisherman. He was an avid fisherman and hunter. He was a great sports fan and enjoyed not only attending games, but also playing and coaching. One of his greatest joys in life was his family, and he particularly enjoyed spending time with his granddaughter Kali Ray. Alvin was a loving husband, father, grandfather, great-grandfather, brother, and so much more. He will be greatly missed by all those that dearly loved him.

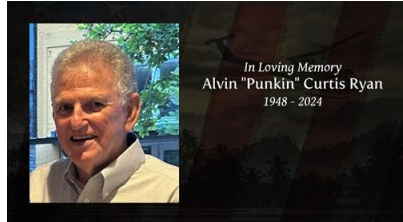
