Beverley Jean Behrend Titzer was born on December 29, 1928 and passed away on September, 9, 2014. She loved music, to sing and do acrobats as a young lady. Beverley was the drum majorette for Oconomowoc High. She earned her pilots license at 17 years of age in Wisconsin. She taught dance for Arthur Murray Studios in the early 50's. She moved to Houma, La in 1955. Beverley was a member of the Amelia Earhart 99'ers, Woman's Pilot Association in the mid 60's to 70's, and was a member of the Terrebonne Sheriff's Flying Posse during the 70's. She was a Girl Scout Leader for over 12 years in the Bayou Care area of Houma. She also owned and managed two travel agencies in Houma and traveled extensively. Beverley was an active member of the Jehovah's Witness Congregations in Safety Harbor, Fl. and in Ponchatoula, La for the last 20 years.

Beverley is survived by her daughters; Kathy (Paul) Meredith of Ponchatoula, La, Cindi Titzer of Mt. Shasta, Ca. and Tina Titzer of North Conway, NH.; her sister, Bonnie (Bill) Engelking of Waukesha, Wi.; brothers, Fred (Evelyn) Behrend and Phil Behrend of Oconomowoc, Wi. and Peter Behrend of Red Granite, Wi.; as well as 4 grandchildren, 7 great-grandchildren, and countless nieces and nephews.

She is preceded in death by her parents, Frederick and Marguerite Behrend; and her brother, Lewis Behrend.
