Neither of us knew what was awaiting us. “A few more items” was most of the home (furniture fit for a 4 bedroom home) and all of those items needed to be wrapped in plastic stretch wrap and some with bubble wrap.

It was a night of chaos.

Under Bonnie's supervision and keen eye for detail, many panicked looks were exchanged behind semi-wrapped furniture that night. The night felt 48 hrs long and although there certainly wasn't any laughter then, there sure is laughter now.

I remember Mandy was exhausted and frustrated but never faltered and didn't cut corners (until we mercifully ran out of wrap) because she wanted to make her mom happy.

Mandy always wanted to make her mom happy and she did that until the very end. The bond they shared was beautiful and powerful. They were blessed to have the relationship they did.

When I think of Bonnie, I think of the affect she left on those around

her. She dazzled us with her beauty and charm and is now dazzling Heaven. XOXO

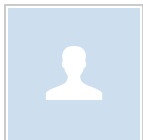

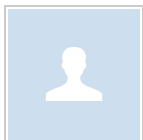
