Carl passed away at the age of 92 on Monday, September 9th, 2024. Born in New Orleans, Louisiana on October 23, 1931. He was a resident of Springfield, Louisiana. 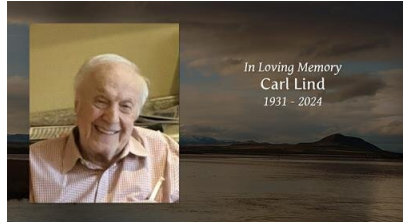
