



Dr. Hollis Lynn Bowman

June 11, 1944 - February 20, 2010

Dr. Hollis Lynn Bowman, 65, of Hazel Green, Alabama passed away on Saturday, February 20, 2010 after a brief illness related to complications from diabetes. Dr. Bowman was a chemist, specializing in forensics and research. He lived in Hammond for many years, graduating from Hammond High School in 1962 and subsequently from Southeastern Louisiana University. He later attended Louisiana State University and The University of Southern Mississippi, earning a Ph.D. in Chemistry. Dr. Bowman was a member of the Flint River Baptist Church in Hazel Green. At the time of his death, he was actively involved with the research and chemistry departments of Alabama A&M University, where he found great enjoyment in assisting students with their research projects.

Dr. Bowman is survived by his daughter, Elizabeth Jane Bowman of Orlando, FL; sister and brother-in-law, Janie and Jimmy Davis of Hazel Green, AL; nephew, Ritchie Lee Murphy and wife Lisa of Prattville, AL; cousin, Jana Dickerson and husband Jimmy of Tickfaw; many friends and co-workers, who will console Dr. Bowman's loved ones' hearts, while also cherishing his memory.

Preceding Dr. Bowman in death were his parents, Hollis Ford Bowman and Ernestine Burns Bowman.
