



Elizabeth 'Liz' Anderson

November 14, 1954 - August 20, 2018

On August 20th Elizabeth Anderson's 10 ½ year journey with ovarian cancer came to an end. During her 63 years of life she was a loving wife; a caring mother of two children, Patrick and Mary; a scholar, graduating from LSU and earning an M.S. Degree from Loyola University; a school teacher in the Plaquemines and Jefferson Parish Public School Systems; an instructor at the University of Holy Cross; the Program Director of the Intensive English Language Program at the University of New Orleans; an educational administrator in Jefferson Parish Public Schools' English Language Acquisition Department; a national educational workshop presenter; the Office Manager of the Ponchatoula Chamber of Commerce; a Louisiana Master Gardener; and a member of the Ponchatoula Gardenettes.

The grace and courage with which she faced her disease served as an inspiration for all those who knew her.

She was preceded in death by her mother and father, Mary and Howard Harrison. She is survived by her husband, Jim; her children, Patrick and Mary, and their spouses, Thao and Duncan Bryant; her brother, Steven Harrison, and his wife, Patty; her sister, Claudia Porche; her nephews Malone, Matthew, and Todd; and her grandchildren, Allison and Chloe.

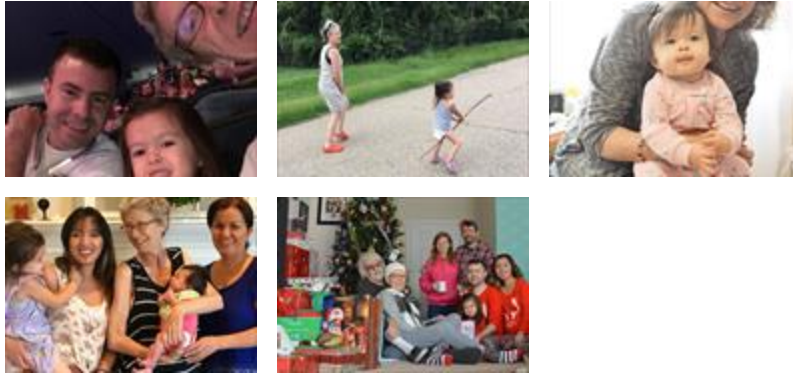

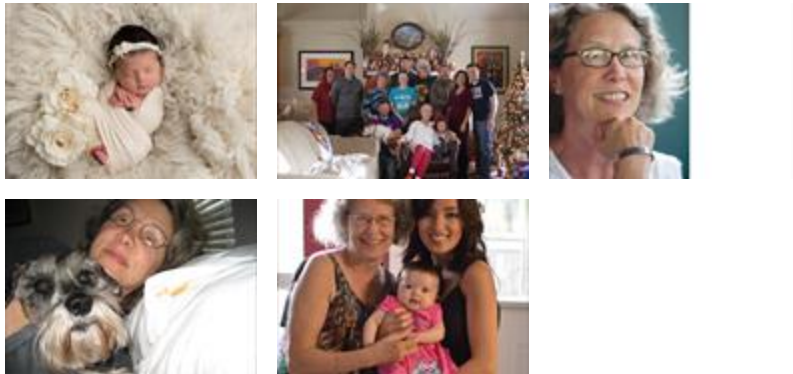
