



## Frances Pauline "Polly" Beyl

Born August 16, 1935. Died May 28, 2023 12.46 pm at North Oaks Memorial Hospital, Hammond, LA.

Pauline or "Polly," aged 87 years, went to her Heavenly Home on Sunday, May 28, 2023 after a short illness.
