We did not share gifts among employees at the center, but he didn't know that and bought me (as "the boss" I'm sure) a gift. It was a small toilet kit with nail clippers, a comb, small pair of scissors in a small case. I was very touched by his gesture but I think he was a bit embarrassed in that he didn't know the other workers were not giving gifts. I still have that gift. I fly planes for a living and travel a lot and still use that gift. A number of years ago I stopped to see him in Ft. Walton Beach and he was in. Purposely I took with me that toilet kit and showed it to him and told him what it had meant to me over the years. I'm sorry to hear of his passing, I've always remembered Frank and the times we worked together.
