Fred Epling Bouchard, 73 years old of Hammond, passed away in Covington, La. on Friday, March 13. He was born in Al Hambra, California, on January 9, 1942, son of the late Frank Bouchard and the late Thelma Epling Bouchard. Fred served in the Air Force, Army Reserves, and Air National Guard, retiring after 33 years with the rank of Master Sergeant. He also was a teacher for 33 years, his career spanning from the Sheltered Workshop, Kentwood High School, and Southeastern Louisiana University. Fred taught welding, foundry, and materials and processes. After retirement, he volunteered at TARC and the Louisiana Special Olympics, where he was honored as state volunteer of the year in 2002. Fred was an avid hunter and outdoorsman who enjoyed the hunt almost as much as the friends he made on the deer stand or in the dove field. He met the love of his life, Judy, and they married in New Orleans at St. Charles Presbyterian Church on June 8, 1963.

Fred is survived by his wife of 51 years, Judith (Judy) Graves Bouchard; daughters Beth (Damon) Ranftle of Ridgeland, MS, and Julie Bouchard, of Columbus, GA; and grandson, Devin Ranftle. He is also survived by his sister, Beth Bouchard (Jack) Mika of La Verne, CA.

He is preceded in death by his parents.
