A graduate of LSU Law School 1948; a member of the Louisiana State Bar Association for over 60 years. He first practiced for the State of Louisiana Internal Revenue Service then joined Amoco Production as an Oil and Gas Attorney in 1955. Upon retirement in 1984 he opened a private practice at Metairie Towers representing clients in the Oil and Gas industry from 1984-2004.

A firm believer in the value of education, he served as a member of the Jefferson Parish School Board from 1962-1968, and as President from 1965-1968.

A veteran of both WWII and the Korean War he served as MP at the Nuremberg Trials and as JAG attorney from 1950-1953. He was a Captain in the 82nd Airborne Division at Fort Bragg, North Carolina, where he obtained his first set of wings.

A second pair of wings was bestowed on April 27th as he departed this earth in a most peaceful manner at his home in Ponchatoula.

He loved his family dearly and spent many happy times together at his camp on the Tangipahoa River and dining at Don's Seafood.

He will be missed by all family, friends and business associates who loved and respected him.

Survived by daughter, Ms. Linda Gibson Fielding, R.N., B.S. of St. Tammany Parish Hospital and son, Dr. George Cinclair Gibson, Jr. Ph.D. of Southeastern Louisiana University, both of Mandeville; daughter, Mrs. Jean Gibson Brauhn of Donaldsonville; step-children, Debbie Grady and Keith Grady of New Orleans, as well as many grandchildren, great-grandchildren, nieces and nephews.
