



Jane Cristina Stoulig

February 11, 1931 - November 4, 2017

Jane Marie Cristina Stoulig was called to her eternal rest on Saturday, November 4 at St. Tammany Parish Hospital in Covington.

She was born in New Orleans on February 11, 1931, the youngest of S. T. Cristina, Sr., and Ethel Rinderle's nine children. Known to her friends and family as Janie, she grew up in old Kenner and graduated from Our Lady of Perpetual Help Catholic School and Dominican High School in New Orleans. She also attended Dominican College. Janie married her childhood sweetheart Richard Stoulig on March 30, 1951 and they had one daughter, Mary Jane.

A devout Catholic, Janie was a parishioner of Our Lady of Perpetual Help Church in Kenner for many decades. She baked cookies for the annual St. Joseph altars, and was an active member in the ladies auxiliary of the Edward J. Stoulig, Sr. Knights of Columbus Council 3528. She also supported missionary work, particularly that of Fr. Benny Piovan, a former pastor at Our Lady of Perpetual Help, and promoted devotion to Padre Pio.

Janie worked at the Metairie Bank and in the accounting department of Ochsner Hospital. She also served as secretary to T. Robert Lacour, a local attorney. She was one of Kenner's first female entrepreneurs, opening her own antique shop and later a baby's clothing store.

One of her favorite pastimes was going down to the family Grand Isle camp where she fished and relaxed with numerous family members and friends. She particularly enjoyed many late nights playing card games with their

guests.

In the 1980s, she and her husband moved to the Robert, Louisiana, where they built their country home, planted a garden, and raised Australian shepherds and chickens. Janie loved her flowers and cared for rabbits, a turkey, goats and even a cow. In her spare time, Janie took several college classes at St Joseph's Abbey, becoming one of the first women to do so. At the time of her death, she was a member of St. Albert Chapel & Catholic Student Center on the Southeastern campus, where she and her husband were active in the Catholic Campus Ministry, serving meals to the college students. She professed vows to the secular Franciscan Third Order on October 15, 1970.

Janie was a devoted and loving wife, mother, grandmother (Nanie), great grandmother and aunt, and was beloved by her family and friends. She will be remembered for her strong will, humor, enthusiasm, kindness, generosity, spirituality, her readiness to help others and her love of her church community family.

She is survived by her daughter Mary Jane Murry (Brad), grandchildren Donald L. Rose III, Monica Prince, Meghan Nelson (Nick), and great-grandchildren Landon Dempsey Prince and Ryleigh Jane Prince. She is also survived by her brother Calvin Cristina, sisters Joy Romig of Kenner and June Mince of Baton Rouge and sister-in laws Adele Stoulig of Houston and Sr. Emerita Stoulig of Oklahoma City. She also leaves over 40 nieces and nephews, as well as grand, great, and great-great nieces and nephews too numerous to mention. She was pre-deceased by her husband of 66 years, Richard, sisters Mildred Lacour and Ethel Fletcher, and brothers Lawrence, Robert and Salvador Thomas Cristina, Jr.
