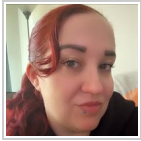
Great-grandchildren Katelynn, Brookelynn, Shane Bartholomew of Louisiana.

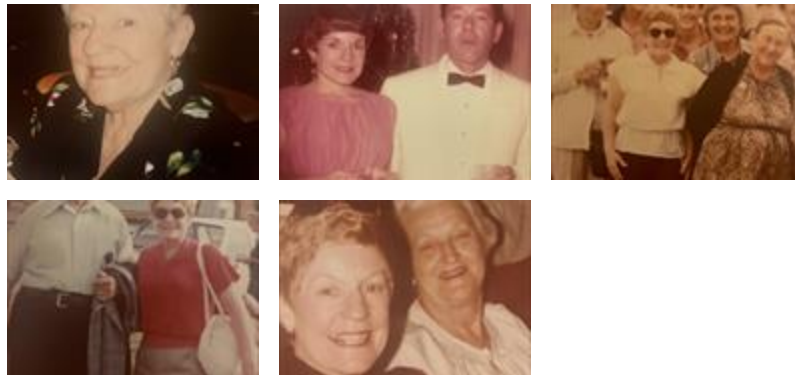
