



Keith Victor Kron

Keith Victor Kron died on May 20, 2024, in New Orleans, the city of his birth. He was 63 years young. Though Keith graduated from Ponchatoula High School in 1979, and later attended Southeastern Louisiana University to study horticulture, New Orleans was always the home of his heart. Inspired by his love of nature and plants, Keith returned to NOLA after college and started his own business – Nature’s Greenhouse – bringing the beauty of plants into the homes and businesses of the city and crafting magical green sanctuaries throughout its gardens.

Keith’s joie de vivre and generosity extended to all he held dear. To his family, he was the most devoted of sons, a stalwart brother, a mischievous uncle who always ensured good fun and a beloved, playful cousin to his Colombian and Louisiana kin. To his friends, he was the consummate host, chef and travel guide, always game for an adventure. To the many creatures he gave refuge – the dogs, the cats, the macaw – he was devoted, tending to their every need and celebrating their endearing idiosyncrasies. All but one of his menagerie survived the home fire that took Keith’s life, who may well have died trying to save the dog that perished with him.

Keith is survived by his mother, Luz Paulina Adam and stepfather Kenneth C. Adam; brothers, Donald J. Kron and his spouse Becky C. Kron, Herman R. Kron and his partner Tina M. Juran, and Kenneth C. Kron; and nephews,

Jason M. and Jeremy C. Durham, Kaenan M. Kron, Caelan P. Spence, Kenneth I. Kron; and his extended family in Bogota and Ponchatoula. He was preceded in death by his father, Donald J. Kron.
