Larry Earl Fuscia, passed away, January 22, 2024 at the age of 82. We are all so blessed to have called him husband, daddy, and pawpaw.

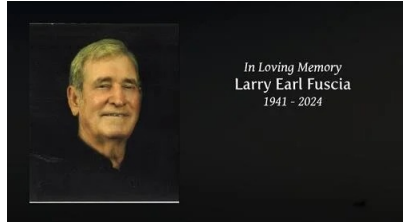
