Larry fought his battle with pancreatic cancer with grace, strength, courage, and an unending tenacity that was fueled, and sustained, by his faith in his Savior, Jesus Christ, along with his genuine passion for his family. The promise of eternity with his Creator brought Larry peace throughout that journey and his desire was to share the love of the Lord with his family and friends as much as possible. That same unfailing promise of God is also what helps ease the pain of his loss. Larry was a loving husband, father, grandfather, and friend who is already dearly missed by all who knew and loved him. Larry worked tirelessly as a Professional Horse Trainer for more than 50 years; training and showing in a variety of disciplines. His favorite, and specialty, over the past 35 years, being Cutting and Working Cow Horse. Having earned countless state, regional, and national titles, to say he was an accomplished horseman would certainly be an understatement. One of his greatest joys was helping his youth and amateur riders to achieve their horsemanship goals. He was a highly respected trainer, coach, and mentor to countless people throughout his career. Most of whom grew to be lifelong friends, some even becoming family. The equine industry was blessed for more than 35 years to have Larry sitting in on multiple statewide, regional, and national boards / committees shaping the equine future in America. Most recently, he actively served/worked as an NRCHA 2A Judge / Clinician, was President of the LQHA, BOD Member for LaSH, and was the Vice President of the SRCHA until his passing.

For more than 18 years, Larry served his local community as a Deputy and Lieutenant Detective with the Tangipahoa Parish Sheriff's Office. During his law enforcement career, he earned a national Heroism Award for his service along with numerous other commendations. Larry served on multiple task forces and tactical groups which collaborated with local, state, and federal agencies throughout his years of service. The lifelong friendships made, and memories shared, with his "Brothers and Sisters In Blue" were forevermore treasured by Larry. His many experiences in law enforcement provided him with a wonderful extended family. Honor, bravery, and integrity were some of his most admirable qualities.

Larry is survived by his loving wife, Genevieve 'GiGi' Cates Westmoreland; daughter, Kelly Leigh Westmoreland Vinyard and her husband Amos Alton Vinyard; and grandchildren; Alex Weston Vinyard, Kade Wyatt Vinyard, and Kaylee Rose Vinyard.
