DiDi was called home to dance for her Lord and Savior Jesus Christ early Monday morning April 9th, 2018. Born in the Philippines but a resident of Hammond, La. She was educated at Angeles University Foundation in Angeles City, Philippines where she received a master's degree in Special Education. She was recruited and subsequently employed by the Baltimore, MD school system where she taught Special Education. Didi's greatest joy was praising and worshipping her Lord and she let everyone know about it. She was diagnosed with a malignant brain stem glioma, an inoperable tumor surrounding her brain stem, in January of 2016. The life expectancy of such a diagnosis is 4 months, but in typical DiDi fashion, she felt her purpose in this life was not yet complete and outlived all Drs. expectations. She was a daughter, sister, teacher, and wife. She was an inspiration and an encourager to ALL who crossed paths. Her faith, not just her deeds, preceded her as her calling in life compelled her to share Christ. She spoke the "truth out of love" to all. She will be missed by many but is now "Perfected" and has made heaven a little bit bigger and hell a little bit smaller.

DiDi is survived by her loving husband, Troy Landry; daughter, Michele Landry; sisters, Luchie Banal Sanchez, Pamela Sanchez; brother, Jose Sanchez; as well as mother, Purification Banal Sanchez.
