The Rhapsody of your life plays on in us.....

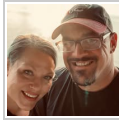

She was such a great lady. Our hearts and prayers are with Jim and all of your family at this difficult time.

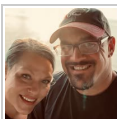

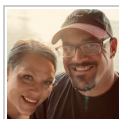

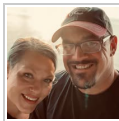
