For the next three years, they wrote to each other while she lived and worked in Paris as a chef for an affluent family in Paris. Monique and Robert married May 20, 1967, and then moved to America. Monique committed herself as a co-leader in the Girl Scouts. Her life was centered around the activities of her family. She was very well known for her hospitality and looked for any excuse to create a nice dinner for friends and family. Her strongest gift was bringing people together over a nicely set table and fine French food. Many fond memories were made over Monique's Tomatos Farcee, tart aux fraise or coquilles St.-Jacques.

Monique is survived by her husband of nearly 50 years, Robert Newton; daughters, Laura Jones, Annette Newton-Baldwin, Sophie Beane, Natalie Sturgis; and grandchildren, Gabrielle Baldwin, Isabelle and Jillian Beane, and Exene and Orion Sturgis.

She is preceded in death by her parents, Raymond and Raymonde Langlet; and sister, Madeline "Mady" Langlet Hardant.

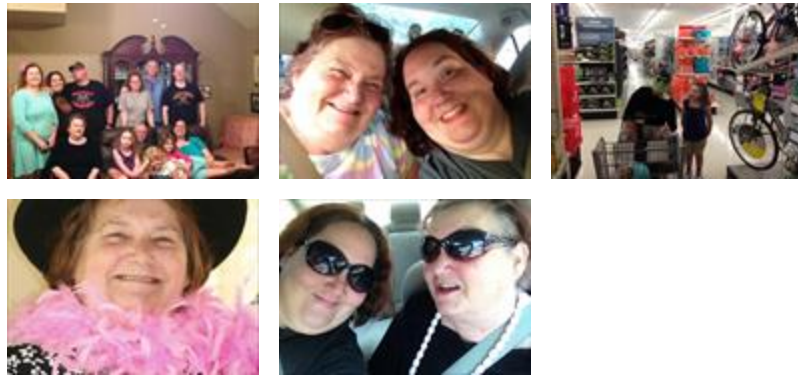

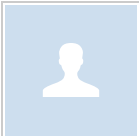
