



## Ornes "Coach" Creppel

Ornes "Coach" Creppel lost his battle with dementia but had a life well lived. He was born and raised in Lafitte with 12 other siblings. He was a son, husband, father, grandfather, great-grandfather, and brother. Ornes earned a track scholarship to college and earned a master's degree. He still holds records from his performances. Teaching and coaching track was his career, and he mentored and coached many students through the Jefferson Parish School System. He served in the United States Army as a Military Police Officer. Ornes was very knowledgeable, and he was "Mister Fix It". He loved flea markets, auctions, antique cars and memorabilia, and finding treasures. He was known for his jokes and making others laugh. At 85 years old, he was immersed in water baptism, as the Bible states "This priceless gift he leaves us with is assurance one day we will be reunited for eternity".

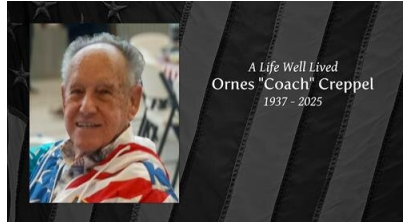
