Patricia "Trish" Corbett, 60, died in Albuquerque, New Mexico, surrounded by family on May 8, 2023. Born on March 1, 1963 she grew up in Holden, Louisiana. She came to know the Lord as a teenager while attending a nearby Church of Christ; the faith she found here was present until the very end and informed every decision she made.

After years of travel as a military spouse, Trish raised her three children in Clarksville, Tennessee and as each one graduated, she encouraged them to spread their wings and follow their dreams. In 2020, Trish moved West to pursue her dream of living in the high desert of New Mexico. She found a special place to call home, a loving community, and immersed herself in the local culture and volunteer efforts, including serving at the Harvey House Museum. She had recently become a member at First Baptist Church of Bosque Farms.
