The entire time Uncle Bill was a police officer, he was also serving in the military. First in the National Guard, which they made him retire from, and then as an Army Reserve NCO.

Since you can't play golf every day, it was apparent Uncle Bill was going to drive our mother, his sister Ruth, completely insane. This is how Uncle Bill came to work for the Probation and Parole office for over 20 years. He was hired to set up and develop this academy, which he took very seriously. He loved being a police officer and when he retired from Baton Rouge Police Department it was like he found another home at probation and parole. He loved teaching and talking and people.
