June 28, 1922 - February 28, 2014

Raymond Kenneth Scott, born on June 28, 1922, went to his Heavenly Home on Friday, February 28, 2014, at the age of 91. He proudly served his country, during World War II, in the United States Army 6th Medical Battalion, as a medic in the Pacific for two years. Afterwards, he transported prisoners of war to various camps in the United States and built underground missile silos, during the Cold War. He never knew the phrase, "I Don't Know How". His philosophy was, "there's always a book on how to do it, so just read it, then do it." He loved tinkering with any type of machinery, building anything that someone needed, reading, fishing and shrimping. He maintained a strong work ethic throughout his entire lifetime, accomplishing the task of building a house, while in his late seventies. Raymond was always there to lend a helping hand to anyone who needed it, no matter what the project. He was a member of Eastside Baptist Church and dearly loved his church family. Raymond was a welder and pipefitter for the Plumbers & Steamfitters Union, Local 60, since 1947, primarily building and performing maintenance within the plants along the river.

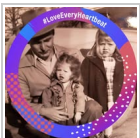
