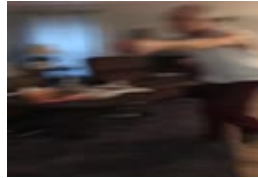
Richard is preceded in death by his parents, Leo and Eleanor Thibodeaux.
