Age 29, Riley lost his life in the line of duty while trying to rescue someone else involved in an automobile accident. He was bravely and honorably attempting to perform his duties as a Springfield Volunteer Fireman. Due to his courage and commitment, Riley will be awarded FULL FIREMAN'S HONORS during his funeral service and burial.

Riley passed away Monday, April 21, 2008 at Our Lady of the Lake Regional Medical Center in Baton Rouge. He was a former employee of Jade Marine in Belle Chase and Jellystone Resort of Robert and was employed with Ferrara Fire Apparatus, Inc of Holden at the time of his death. Riley was a native of Buras, La until his family reestablished themselves in Springfield after Hurricane Katrina. Riley's dad, Riley, Sr is employed with Paul L. Cook Boat Rental in Buras.

He is survived by his son, Andre Terrebonne; parents, Riley, Sr. and Pamela Squarsich Terrebonne; sister, Jennifer Terrebonne; nephews, Dylan and Leroy Latham; niece, Hailey Book and many extended family members, friends and brotherly volunteer fire fighters.

Preceding him in death are his grandparents, Mercy and James Squarsich, Louise and Nelson Verrett, Pierre Terrebonne, Sr. and brother-in-law, Leroy Latham, Jr.
