



## Ronald J. Lloyd

July 26, 1934 - January 27, 2008

In June of 1987, Ronald J. Lloyd retired as Assistant Chief of Police for the City of Hammond, after having worked for 26 years. He was a charter member of the "Ronald Reagan Republican Presidential Task Force" and served in the United States Army in the 12th Ordinance Battalion from 1954 through 1957. Ronald was a member of Woodland Park Baptist Church.

A native of Oneida, Tennessee and a resident of Hammond, he passed away Sunday, January 27, 2008, leaving his beloved wife of 40 years, Ruby Craig Lloyd; two sons, Allen Lloyd, Ronnie and Sarrah Lloyd, all of Hammond.
