Sgt. First Class Roscoe Michael Downey, age 59, and a longtime resident of Hammond, passed away unexpectedly on Monday, June 27, 2011 in Tennessee. Sgt Downey was retired from the Louisiana National Guard, a Certified Master Trainer and Chief Instructor at the Louisiana Military Academy for Leadership, Officer Candidate and Construction School. Prior to becoming an instructor, he served as a Tactical Commo Chief with national/secret security clearance and as a Heavy Combat Engineer.
