Sal was called to his heavenly home on Monday, August 23, 2021 at the age of 74. He was a resident of Ponchatoula, Louisiana where he was known to be a dedicated family man who loved and adored his family. Sal was a committed member of St. Joseph's Catholic Church for over 45 years. He was the backbone of morning mass, leading the rosary every morning for the church. Sal was very devoted to our Blessed Virgin Mary. He was a founding member and Secretary Treasurer for Miracle of the Rosary Mission, where he took on the responsibility of Prayer Group's national short waves radio. 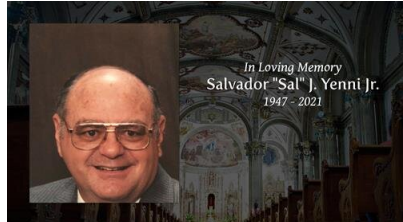
