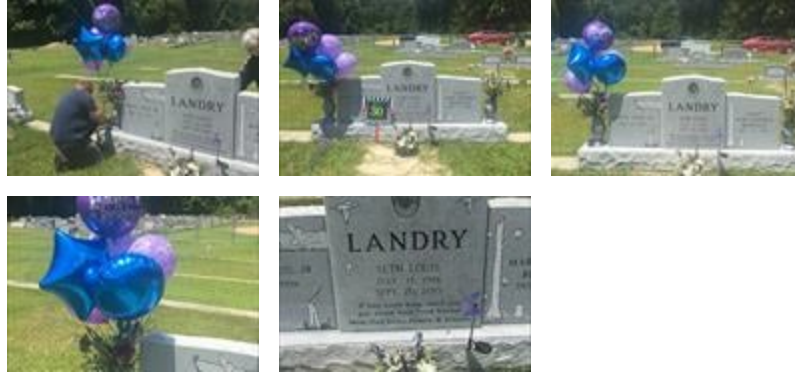

As you can imagine tomorrow is going to be one of the worst days since we lost Seth, especially for our parents...can you even imagine trying to get through the day that was once the most treasured day of every year since 1986, the day their beautiful baby boy was born only to have to take balloons & flowers to his grave for the first time and then having to face the fact that from now on every year on July 13th we will never again bake him a birthday cake (he LOVED any homemade cake Mom &/or I would bake for him, I remember a few years ago he requested that I make mini chocolate molten lava cakes that year...me, Jeremy & the girls all loaded up & headed to Mom & Dads house where we knew Seth would be each year waiting to celebrate his big day w/ us, and he was always all about it...in the latter years I can't say for sure that he was sincerely excited. about growing another year older but you wouldn't have ever known because he knew just how excited his youngest niece Kenzie gets over birthday celebrations...chocolate is her fave so that year it may as well have been her birthday too, I remember bringing all my cake supplies in the house to get ready to prepare & bake, he was always right there w that big beautiful smile & those gorgeous blue eyes of his greeting us all w hugs, kisses & tickles... if he could at all possibly sneak the tickle part in, watch out cause he loved to hear us screaming & begging him to stop (I still don't understand what is so gratifying about torturing those you love w horribly painful tickle sessions)...I remember being nervous about the end result of his chocolate molten lava cakes since of course I had never made them before but of course they came out perfect but even if they wouldn't have been that great he would have never in a million years let me think they were anything but the best he as ever had. We put candles in his the best we could a desert like that & w his 2 nieces on each side of him, w all sang happy birthday while he grinned like he was a little kid again & then he always made sure to let Kenzie help him blow out his candles as if he just could have never done it w out her help! Tomorrow will be much different from the way we have spent July 13th every year for the last 29 years...instead of all that

wonderful stuff I told about earlier (which now I see how many things, times, moments were taken for granted out of never thinking that that would be the last), I have placed an order w the local florist to prepare a basket of flowers in Blues & purples I will pick up at 11 tomorrow morning the go out to our parents house, only to not have the birthday boy waiting there to greet me like the years before but instead to meet up w our parents whom are going in the morning to pick up the balloon order they made at the party store today, attach the balloons to the basket of flowers, and all (Us, Jeremy, the girls & Carson) head to the cemetery to place his birthday flowers & balloons on his headstone & stare at the huge block of concrete w/ the beautiful birthday boys face on it & the words that are supposed to make it reality that "Seth Louis Landry" was born July 13, 1986 & that he died on September 20, 2015...I don't know if we will dare be able to get through singing happy birthday to him like we always have before because I imagine we will still feel like we have every other time that we have stood there since his funeral on Dec 5, 2015...in complete & utter disbelief that he is really gone, the unnerving feeling that there's no way that our Seth's bones are in that coffin buried beneath our feet (this is what the closure that most people get when they loose a loved one, actually seeing w their own 2 eyes the body of the person they loved so dearly laying there so quiet & so still, that was stolen from us in the most heinous manner, has left us with), we will cry like we do everytime we go & so many times in between, we will talk about the many regrets & share a few not so regretful memories too I'm sure then we will each in our own way tell him Happy Birthday, how much we miss him & how much we love him. Then Mom & I will kiss his picture good bye before we leave and just like that...what was once one of the happiest days of every year has instantly become one of the saddest days of the rest of our years here on Earth!

I miss you more & more each day that goes by, the has not healed or made this nightmare feel any less painful not any less real at the same time! I love you & miss you more than words can describe! I hope they are planning the biggest best birthday celebration imaginable up there in Heaven right now

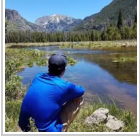
