



Tyrone Michael Coyle Sr.

October 1, 1947 - December 3, 2021

Tyrone Michael Coyle Senior, on Friday, December 3rd 2021 at the age of 74 was called home to be with the Lord after a prolonged struggle with lung cancer. He was born in New Orleans, LA on October 1st 1947 to Cornelius F. Coyle (father) and Vivian Coyle (née Young) (mother). Tyrone was a proud native of New Orleans' Irish Channel, devout Catholic, entrepreneur and loving family man. He was educated at St. Alphonsus school and Alcée Fortier High School in New Orleans and then at the University of New Orleans. As a young man, he was the owner and proprietor of Chachee's restaurant in Uptown New Orleans and later the founder of Uptown Seafood in the Garden District of New Orleans. He married Cathy Coyle (née Barousse), his wife of 42 years on December 2, 1979 and had his only child (Tyrone (Ty) Coyle Junior) on April 22nd 1984.

He went on to found TMC Renovations and spent over a decade renovating homes throughout the greater New Orleans area. After his own home was devastated from Hurricane Katrina, he relocated with his wife to nearby Hammond, Louisiana. After surviving near-fatal Guillain-Barré infection, he transitioned to a maintenance supervisor position with a local assisted-living facility. Tyrone retired in 2017 and then settled in Albany, Louisiana where he spent his final years renovating his home and nature watching. He was also an avid horse-racing enthusiast, who also enjoyed spending time with family and pets.

His death was preceded by his brothers Cornelius (Neice) Coyle, John (Bickey) Coyle and half-brother Curtis (CJ) Barrois. He is survived by his remaining family: Cathy Coyle (wife), Tyrone (Ty) Coyle Junior (son), Melissa Herbert (son's fiancé) and half-sister Catherine Tassin (née Barrois). Per his wishes, there will be no funeral service. The family encourages all condolences, stories and photos to be shared.
