“ Mr. Windle B. "Wink" Morgan was a very kind man, who I suppose never met a stranger. He and my dad grew up together in Montpelier.

*When I was about 9 years old I had occasion to really need "Mr. Wink", as I called him. We were deep into the remote woods of Tensas Parish deer hunting when my father fell from a broken deer tree stand shattering his leg.*

*Injured on the forest floor miles from civilization with only a young boy to help was not a desirable situation. Lying on the ground in pain, my father said to me, "Run get Wink!"*

*I ran through the woods along a tiny dirt "road" and to my surprise, I found Wink already coming toward us. Through the woods he had heard the volley of rifle fire that my father had used as a distress signal.*

*With apparent military training as a medic, Wink went to work stabilizing my daddy's leg with a homemade middle-of-the-woods Wink Morgan splint. We all followed Wink's medical instructions and with the help of my grandfather and others, we managed to get my dad out of those woods to an orthopedist several hours away.*

*With surgery the leg was saved. The splint worked perfectly and, as I recall, the doctors credited that Wink Morgan splint with saving my dad's leg!!*

*My dad has many other stories, growing up with Wink and his family. Wink was a great friend to me and my family, as I know he was for many others! We will never forget his kindness and friendship. Mr. Wink will live on in our memories for as long as we live.*

*God bless Wink's family, as we share some small part of the pain that they surely feel with his loss. All who knew Wink are feeling the*

*loss today.*
